As part of a wide network of like-minded individuals and groups, your organisation can benefit as follows:

	FULL MEMBERS	AFFILIATE MEMBERS
1. THE FAIR:	The offer of a place at the Greener Abergavenny Annual Fair.	For Capacity reasons, the offer of a place at the Greener Abergavenny Annual Fair is NOT guaranteed for Affiliate Members.
2. PUBLICITY:	Publicising events and activities to a wide audience via social media and email distribution lists.	As left
3. INFORMATION:	Receive Information about other activities in the area that may be of interest, or where there may be synergy.	As left
4. RESOURCES:	Support for finding resources, enlisting people from across the community, contacts etc.	As left
5. FUNDING:	Support for funding applications, awareness of funding opportunities.	As left
6. INFLUENCE	A seat at Greener Abergavenny Steering Group meetings. One or several people are welcome to attend.	Affiliate Member organisations are welcome to send a representative(s) to Greener Abergavenny Steering Group meetings. However, attendance is not expected.
7. VOTING	Membership entitles a single vote at the meetings when relevant on behalf of the member organisation.	Affiliate Membership does not allow an attendee to vote unless an exception is specifically agreed by the officers of Greener Abergavenny.
8. PARTICIPATION	All organisations are encouraged to support other member organisations activities. So if help is needed, there is an option to make a request to all other member for support.	
9. COMMUNITY	All Members can expect to feel a part of a wider group of individuals and organisations that share a common interest and support aligned to the aims of Greener Abergavenny.	

Full members are expected to attend Steering Group Meetings on a regular basis, with deputies if unable to attend.

All Members are asked to support Greener Abergavenny and other members by distributing information that they consider to be relevant and of interest to their own social media and members via e-mail distribution.

Members of Full and Affiliated organisations are (as are all in the community) encouraged to support local projects which will materialise from time to time across a range of “green” themes that may be of particular interest or resonance to their members.
